OUR PARISH RECTORY AND OFFICE NEEDS HELP

As of a few weeks ago, what was a small leak began to pour gallons of water into the upstairs bedrooms of the parish office and rectory. The roof has rotted completely through in many areas, including the framework holding the roof. Also, most of the concrete façade is falling backwards, creating a serious hazard. Due to the age and condition of the rectory roof, it is necessary to replace most of it. However, our budget was only prepared to pay \$30,000 for a new roof coat, not the rotted wood, framing and replacement of the façade. We now need in the excess of \$70,000. Therefore, anyone willing to help financially subsidize this work would be greatly appreciated. Please call the office if you would be willing to donate for this need. Any financial assistance is most appreciated.

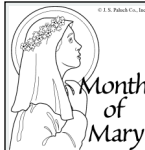
